

Annie Will Wright



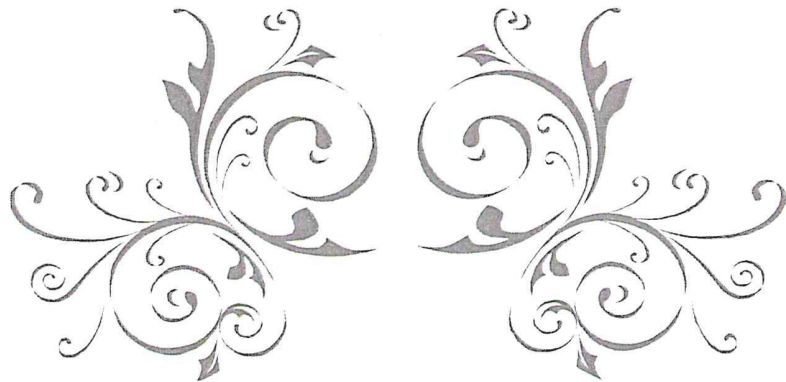
Annie Will Wright was born in Russell County on December 22, 1911, to Elizabeth Stallworth and Allen Perry, who have preceded her in death.
