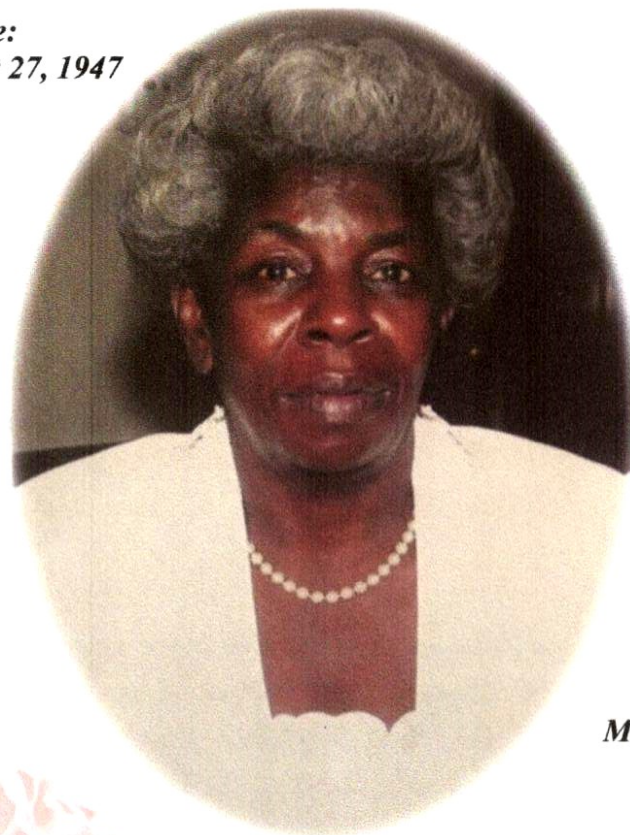

Janie Mae Perdue transitioned to her eternal home at Princeton Baptist Medical Center in Birmingham, Alabama on May 18, 2019.

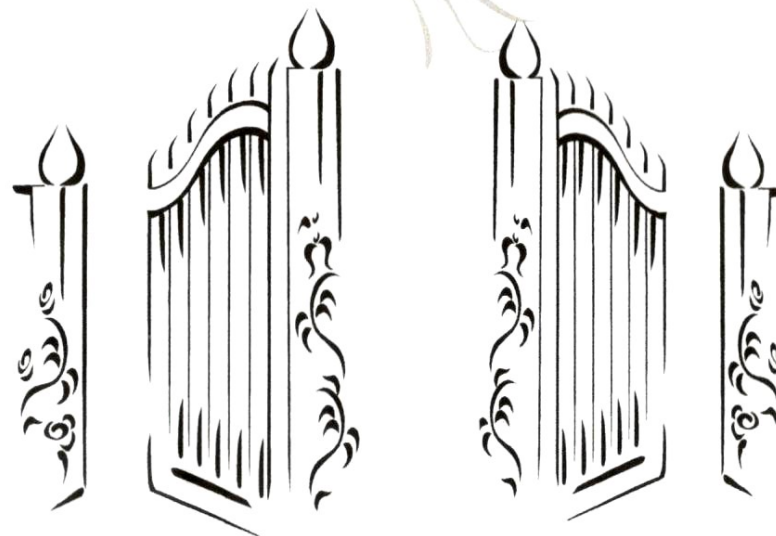
